Recently we were able to verify that all HRM owned plots in the area have been designated as park lands.

Overall, we (SLCA and SRA) are continuing to work on avenues to expand the park lands between Sandy Lake and the Sackville River. We are making presentations to potential Coalition members and continuing conversations that should help the effort.

The area's importance as a corridor connecting the Chebucto Peninsula to the mainland was clearly recognized in the recent Green Network Plan.

We had an encouraging meeting with the developers, Clayton, who demonstrated willingness to find a solution with us.

We will need strong support within Council if this is to succeed. When the time comes, we will let you know of the public action planned. In the meantime, we hope you will continue to mention to your councillors and others the valuable natural asset that exists here.
